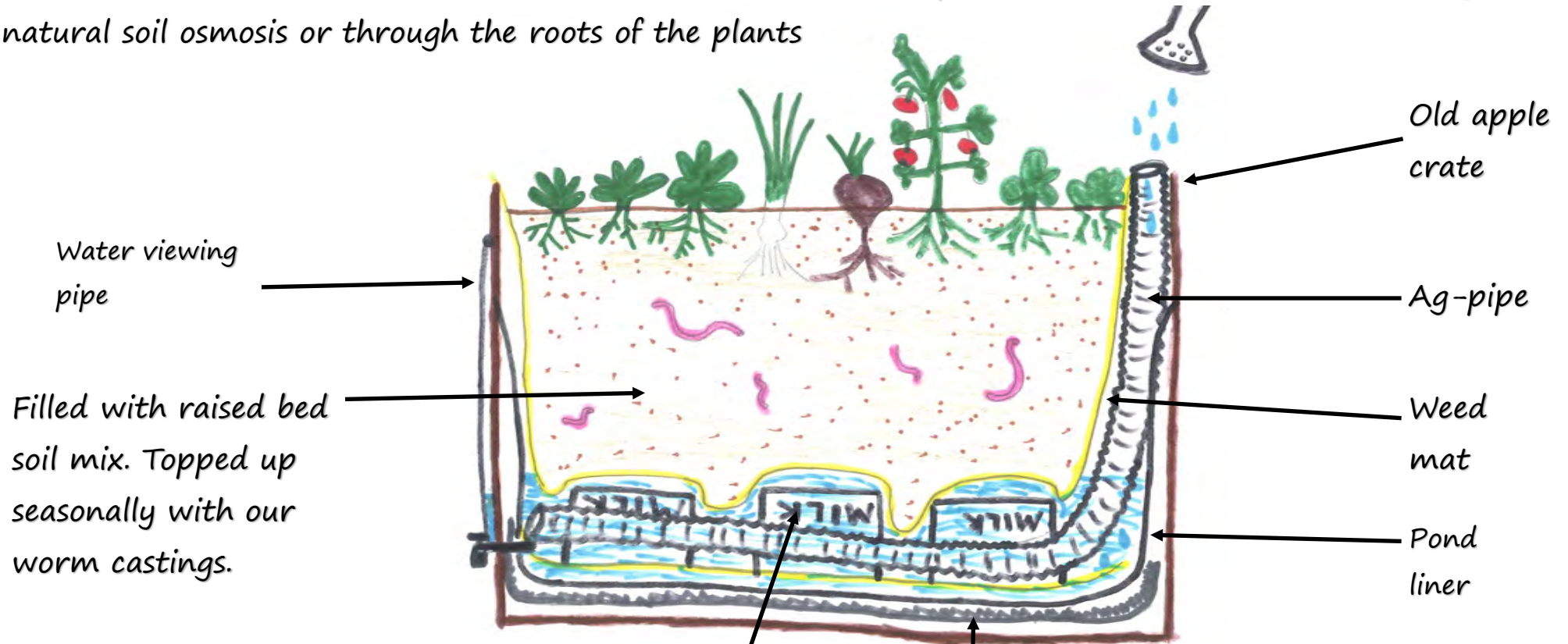


This is a Wicking Bed

The crate (such as an apple crate, 1.2 metres square) is lined with a waterproof lining that holds a reservoir of water at the bottom from which water is drawn upwards like a wick to the surface by natural soil osmosis or through the roots of the plants



Filled with raised bed soil mix. Topped up seasonally with our worm castings.

Water only needs to be topped up every 2-3 weeks in summer & much less in winter

Old Milk crates (to create water reservoir)

Old Carpet

The wicking bed uses between 40 and 50% less water than a conventional garden bed.
